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1. American Crow. Four teams counted the large evening flight of American Crow to their roost site at the UW-Bothell campus. This accounted for 2,453 crows in Area 7S, 127 in Area 2, 3,276 in area 8, and 4,573 in area 9S for a total of 10,429 crows. The numbers shown in the individual areas reflect the crows seen using the habitat outside of the hours of the morning and evening roost flights.

2. Boat party. The boat party was not able to go out this year. This had a negative impact on seabird numbers.

3. Crow Counters. The crow counting teams covered four specific sites in areas 2, 9s, 8, and 7s. The counts are in the American Crow total. The time, distance, and number of observers / parties are included in each area.

4. CW stands for Count Week. These are species that were found within the count circle in the 3 days prior or the 3 days after the count; but, not on the count day.
