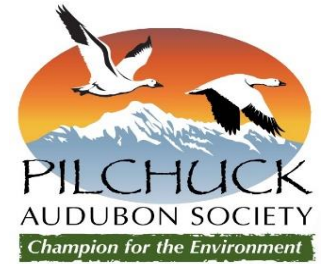

### Instructions:

The driving tenant here is that it is the effort of the party—not the individual—that we need. For example: the effort of 3 individuals walking together 1 mile is not 3 miles, it is 1 mile for the party.

A route re-traced on foot should only include the one-way distance. For example: If a field party walks out a path through a woodland to a distance of 1 1/2 miles and returns the same way, the distance is reported as 1 1/2 miles, not 3. The entire time spent on the path should be reported, not just that of the one-way distance.

Please round all hours to the nearest quarter-hour, and all distances to the nearest quarter-mile.

Unusual birds are listed in ***Bold Italics*** in the species list. Please attempt to get a photo, good description and location. You may be asked to fill out a rare bird report on these. Any bird not on this list is rare and should be photographed and/or described on the rare bird report.
